Dave and Jackie Bos – a Michigan native and a California girl blending their love for biodynamic farming, great design, and exceptional wine. After years in Napa Valley, they've brought their passions to Northern Michigan, where BOS Wine connects the best of both regions.

Their journey began in Napa, where Dave was the biodynamic vineyard manager at Grgich Hills Estate and Jackie led major projects at a landscape architecture firm. In 2008, they married with a shared dream of building something together. That dream became BOS Wine in 2010, starting with just 48 cases of Syrah and a commitment to craft-driven, biodynamically inspired winemaking.

Dave's roots in Michigan remained strong, and they often returned to visit family and watch the local wine scene grow. Inspired by the region's potential, they made the leap by moving their family and business to Elk Rapids. Today, they proudly run the BOS Wine Garden, their tasting room in downtown Elk Rapids, where they share wines made from both California and Michigan grapes.

Jackie leads the brand and label design, creating clean, bold visuals rooted in story and nature. Dave continues to farm, consult, and champion organic and biodynamic practices across Michigan vineyards.

Together, they're excited to be part of Michigan's wine future—one glass at a time.
