## VARIETAL:

Blaufränkisch

## VINEYARD:

This fruit is from Vineyard 15 located on the north end of Old Mission Peninsula overlooking the East Bay with sandy loam limestone soil. While the site is typically cool, a warm spell at the end of the 2023 growing season allowed the fruit to ripen more fully, resulting in exceptional concentration and depth.

## CELLAR:

One-third of the fruit was fermented as cluster adding a layer whole of tannins structured and earthu complexity. Aged for 10 months in used puncheon barrels, the wine matured slowly, allowing the fruit's character to through with minimal shine oak influence. Deliciously bright and ready to enjoy now, with the balance to age gracefully and develop even more depth.
