

# BOS Shipwreck

### VARIETAL:

Blaufränkisch, Pinot Noir, & Lagrein

### VINEYARD:

This fruit comes from three different vineyards on Old Mission Peninsula. Blaufränkisch brings brambly fruit and black pepper, Lagrein adds spice and depth, and Pinot Noir contributes roundness with a supple texture. All together, they reflect both the warmth of the season and the elegance of Northern Michigan.

### CELLAR:

The fruit was given a light, soft press to preserve purity and finesse, then aged for ten months in used French oak. This gentle approach highlights the bright fruit character while allowing subtle complexity to develop. The result is a smooth, balanced red with soft tannins and vibrant fruit on the palate.
